- House Minority Whip (2001-2002)

War crime charge(s):

- Complicity in the commission of a war crime--torture, ill-treatment of detainees.
- Was among the few Congressional leaders who were briefed about waterboarding and other "harsh interrogation techniques" as early as 2002 and she did not object. Viewed tapes of torture but did not act¹.
- Blocked impeachment investigations/proceedings against George W. Bush

Primary Association:

- Speaker of the House of Representatives
